

Accordingly, all aggrieved students, their parents and others can submit their grievances to the GRC of GIET in writing. The grievances of all aggrieved students, parents and others relates to the following complaints only (as per AICTE rules & regulations) shall be considered i.e.-

- (i) Making admission contrary to merit determined in accordance with the declared admission policy of the institute.
- (ii) Irregularity in the admission process adopted by the institute.
- (iii) Refusing admission in accordance with the declared admission policy of the institute.
- (iv) Withhold or refuse to return any document with it by a person for the purpose of seeking admission in such institution, with a view to induce or compel such person to pay any fee or fees in respect of any course or programme of study which such person does not intend to pursue.
- (v) Demand of money in excess of that specified in the declared admission policy or approved by the competent authority to be charged by such institution.
- (vi) Breach of the policy for reservation in admission as may be applicable. Complaints of alleged discrimination by students from scheduled Caste, Scheduled Tribes, OBC, women, minority or disabled categories.
- (vii) Nonpayment or delay in payment of scholarships to any students that such institution is committed, under the conditions imposed by AICTE, or by any other authority.
- (viii) Delay in conduct of examinations or declaration of results beyond that specified in the academic calendar.
- (ix) On provision of student amenities as may have been promised or required to be provided by the institution.
- (x) Denial of quality education as promised at the time of admission or required to be provided.
- (xi) Non transparent or unfair evaluation practices.
- (xii) Harassment and victimization of students including sexual harassment and
- (xiii) Refund of fees on withdrawal of admissions as per AICTE instructions from time to time. For speedy redress of all grievances, the Grievance Redressal Committee of GIET shall take a decision within 15 days of receipt of grievance and the decision shall be informed to the concerned complaint.

xii) Establishment of Internal Compliant Committee: Constituted

Internal Complaints Committee (ICC):

As per law, it is mandatory for every workplace to have an Internal Complaints Committee (ICC) that would a critical role in prevention, prohibition and redressal of sexual harassment at the work place. The ICC has a responsibility to establish an effective internal complaints procedure, where:

- Assurance that no victimization will result from making a complaint.
- Procedure is well documented, available and in accessible formats.
- Members who manage complaints are well trained.
- Assistance is provided in the form of language interpreters as needed for parties to a complaint.
- Ensuring the process is confidential, independent and based on principles of natural justice.
- Ensuring the process has clear timelines.
- All conflicts of interest are managed appropriately.

In pursuance of UGC [Prevention, prohibition and redressal of sexual harassment of women employees and students in higher educational Institutions] Regulations, 2015 read with sexual Harassment of Women at Workplace [Prevention, prohibition and redressal] Act,2013 and in partial modification of Office Order No. 449 dated 02.08.2016,the Internal Complaints Committee (ICC) is reconstituted as under to deal with the complaints relating to Sexual Harassment at work place.

On receipt of a complaint ICC shall conduct preliminary enquiry so as to ascertain the truth of the allegations by collecting the documentary evidence as well as recording statements of any possible witnesses including the complainant. ICC shall then submit the preliminary enquiry report to Convenor/Disciplinary authority along with all the original documents adduced during the preliminary enquiry proceedings. In case the allegations are not in the nature of sexual harassment, ICC may refer such complaints to the Grievance Redressal Cell or to Registrar.

Where sexual harassment occurs as a result of an act or omission by any third party or outsider, ICC shall take all steps necessary and reasonable to assist the affected person in terms of support and preventive action.

ICC shall comply with the procedure prescribed in the aforementioned UGC Regulations 2015 and the Sexual Harassment Act for inquiring into the complaint in a time bound manner.

If ICC concludes that the allegations made were false, malicious or the complaint was made knowing it is to be untrue or forged or misleading information has been provided during the enquiry, the complaint ant shall be liable to be punished as per the relevant provision of the aforementioned UGC Regulations 2015.

Member Secretary/ Chairperson, ICC shall receive the complaints of Sexual Harassment, if any, on behalf of ICC and shall co-ordinate the deliberations of the ICC on the complaints received.

Who can approach to ICC for help:

Any female employee (Faculty, Students or Staff) of GIET, Bhubaneswar.

Sexual Harassment:

"Sexual Harassment" includes any unwelcome sexually inclined behavior, whether directly or indirectly such as:

- Physical contact and advances.
- Demand or request for sexual favours.
- Sexually colored remarks.
- Showing any pornography, or
- Any other unwelcome physical, verbal or non-verbal conduct of sexual nature.

Possible actions that can be taken against the respondent:

- Warning
- Written apology
- Bond of good behavior
- Adverse remark in the Confidential Report.
- Stopping of increments/promotion
- Suspension
- Dismissal
- Any other relevant actions

Inquiry Process:

- The enquiry shall be completed within a period of seven days from the date of the complaint.
- On completion of the enquiry, the ICC shall provide a report of its findings to the employer within
 a period of ten days from the date of completion of the enquiry and such report be made available
 to the concerned parties.
- If the allegations against the respondent have been proved, it shall recommend punitive actions to be taken against the respondent to the employer.
- The employer shall act upon the recommendation within 15 days of receiving it.

Role of SC/ST Committee:

The Committee will meet the concerned students, understand their problem and take necessary action and/or render them necessary advice/help to resolve the matter.

Objectives of SC/ ST Committee:

According to the UGC Guidelines of 1998, following are the objectives of the Committee as follows.

- The syllabus is distributed over a number of semesters. Grasp and knowledge of the subject is evaluated in bits continuously and periodically thereby putting lesser burden on the student as compared to evaluation by one examination at the end of the session.
- The courses allotted for a particular semester are completed by the end of the semester and also examined and evaluated simultaneously, thereby reducing the amount of material to be studied at one time.
- The mode of evaluation is also varied, depending upon the nature of the subjects and topics. In general, the following components of evaluation are adopted:

- The student's performance is assessed throughout the semester by continuous evaluation followed by an end-semester examination which covers the entire syllabus.
- The number of credits allotted to each course depends on the relative time a student is expected to devote for the respective course.
- Each component of evaluation is assigned a certain weight age towards the computation of over-all performance in each course.
- Mark grade sheet is issued by University after evaluation of each semester and the declaration of the result of each academic session is based on student's performance over both the semesters of the session. An academic session means both the semesters of the session taken together.
- The student's performance for a session is indicated through a result card issued to the student after each even end-semester examination of a session which shows his achievements in each of the courses registered for.

f) Student's assessment of Faculty System in place :- Yes Available

Feedback about Faculty is taken from students twice a semester. The various parameters on which teaching is assessed are: Communication Skills, Quality of Teaching/ Academic input, Subject Knowledge, Content and Method of Delivery, Resourcefulness, Readiness of teacher, Accessibility and Availability of Teacher in Campus/ Department. Feedback is signed by the Principal and conveyed to the faculty by respective Head of the Department.
